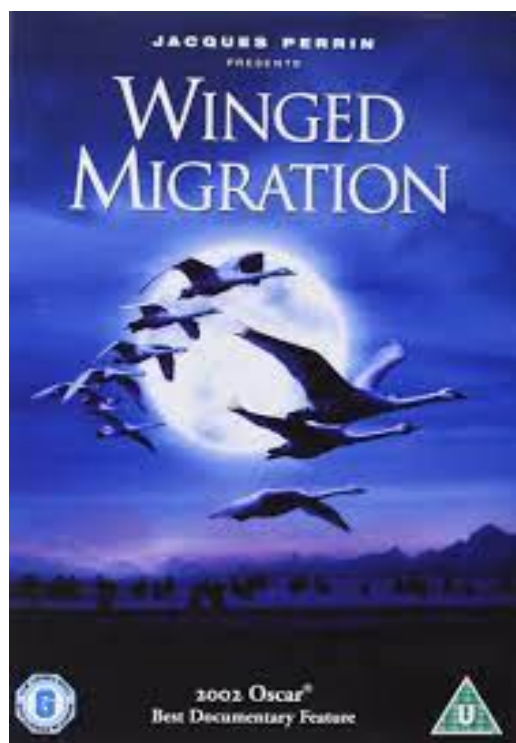




Tryon Farm Institute Nature Film Series
