2021 Accomplishments

Grant Status:

- \$190k Barn restoration kick off \$65k in 2021 donations; \$50k Grant submission in October. *Actively fundraising*.
- Tryon Prairie (Ebbies Meadow) Received \$7.5k USDA grant December 21 planting of 6 acres with native grasses and wildflowers
- IWF partnership Received \$15k Huff Trust Grant Restore Werner Pond in 2022 creating habitat for wood ducks

Land Management:

- Project Wingspan Partnership Tryon is now an official seed collection site
- Expanded trail network on new 11 acre land acquisition
- West Meadow & New Property Invasive species eradication work continues
- Pollinator garden expansion Our work in 20 paid off as the plants are doing great!
- 30 new shrubs; Ephemeral planting days; new evergreeens along Eastwood

- Barn restoration work begins in June 2022! Fundraising Continues
- Tryon Prairie (Ebbies Meadow) Monitor 1st year of planting
- Huff Trust Grant Complete Werner Pond restoration

- Project Wingspan Partnership Collect seed from native prairie plants
- Woodchip all trails in 5k trail that need it (new Gator will help with this)
- West Meadow & New Property Invasive species eradication work continues
- Front Prairie Remove woodies and prepare burn plan
- Pollinator garden expansion Continue to expand native plantings in barnyard area
- Expand shrub layer throughout the 120 acres TFI manages
